ADMISSION PREREQUISITES

- The child must be the appropriate age by August 31st of the school year you are applying.
 - Kindergarten (5 years old by 8/31).
- The application procedure must be followed as outlined below. This includes submitting the non-refundable \$100 application fee. If you wish to be considered for multiple campuses, please rank the order of preference on the application.



This application is for Cedar Crest Academy's Redmond and Kirkland campuses only.

Applications can be submitted by mail or in-person to the campus you are applying to. Applications will not be considered unless submitted with the required non-refundable application fee (waived for current Cedar Crest families). Applications must be received by **Friday, February 4th, 2022**. Please apply only for the coming School Year. Please note that applications are not considered in the order received; all applications go into a general pool from which students are chosen. Acceptance letters will be sent out on or before **Monday, February 28, 2022**.

Tuition

Cedar Crest Elementary's annual tuition for the 2022-2023 School Year (September through June) is \$21,500. This amount may be paid monthly, quarterly, or annually (please see schedule below).

Cedar Crest requires that tuition payments are made through *Sandbox*, our online registration platform, and an automatic tuition withdrawal program (ACH). The process is simple and convenient and has no cost to parents. Tuition withdrawals may be tracked in your monthly bank statements and will be withdrawn on the <u>10th day of each month</u> and will be applied to the following month's fees. (For example, tuition will be withdrawn on August 10th and will be applied to September's fees.) **All deposits and fees are entirely non-refundable**.

2022-2023 TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS (KINDERGARTEN - 5TH GRADE)

A one month deposit is applied to June 2023

Monthly

\$2,160 per month, due on the 10th of each month and is applied to the following month's fees. (Includes \$10 processing fee)

Quarterly

\$6,367 due on August 10th, November 10th, and February 10th. (\$250 Discount)

Annually

\$18,850 due August 10th. (\$500 discount)



Included in the Full Day Program's Monthly Tuition

- Healthy and nutritious lunches and snacks.
- Three to four Specialists per grade level are selected each year by the school. Some examples of Specialists have been: Spanish, Art, Physical Education, Library, and Technology.
- Students will participate in Clubs during the school day, led by the teacher specializing in subjects such as performing arts, journalism, photography, cooking, computer technology, and more.

Discounts

- 10% discount for single-parent families
- 5% sibling discount (applies to each additional sibling)
- <u>Tuition is not pro-rated or discounted</u> for vacations, time away, or foreseen or unforeseen school closures.
- Only one discount may be applied. Discounts may not be combined.

Deposit & Annual Fees

- For those entering Kindergarten through Fifth Grade, a deposit of one month's tuition is required and will be credited towards tuition in June.
- In addition to a deposit of one month's tuition, annual fees, including a Registration Fee and Education Fee, are required for enrollment. The Registration Fee is \$150.00 for all students. The Education Fee varies based on grade level:
 - \$1,000 for Kindergarten through Second Grade
 - \$1,100 for Third through Fifth Grade.
- Deposit and Annual Fees are non-refundable.
