


Thank you for your interest in Cedar Crest Academy! Before applying, please familiarize yourself with our Application Procedure, outlined below. We ask you to carefully consider your child's early education goals as children benefit from continuity and familiarity. We appreciate applicants who are looking to continue in our program for multiple years.

When answering the parent questions, please take the time to reply thoroughly and thoughtfully. Feel free to attach any additional documents that will help us get to know your child. We may ask applicants with incomplete applications to come to the school for a play date to determine enrollment. Thank you again for considering Cedar Crest Academy. ADMISSION PREREQUISITES

- The child must be the appropriate age by August 31st of the school year you are applying.
 - Young Preschool (30 months by 8/31)
 - Preschool (3 years old by 8/31)
 - Pre-Kindergarten (4 years old by 8/31)
- **The child must be fully potty-trained. No pull-ups or nap time diapers are allowed.**
- The application procedure must be followed as outlined below. This includes submitting the non-refundable \$100 application fee. If you wish to be considered for multiple campuses, please rank the order of preference on the application.



Please apply for the coming School Year only. Applications can be submitted by mail or in-person to the campus you are applying to. Applications will not be considered unless submitted with the required non-refundable application fee (waived for current Cedar Crest families). Applications must be received by **Friday, February 4th, 2022**. No priority is given based on the application date, and applications may not be submitted more than a year in advance. If the School Year has already begun, contact the campus you are interested in directly to schedule a tour and check availability.

Tuition

Tuition is paid monthly in accordance with a signed Enrollment Agreement. Cedar Crest requires that tuition payments are made through *Sandbox*, an automatic tuition withdrawal program (ACH). The process is simple and convenient and has no cost to parents.

Tuition withdrawals will be drawn on the 10th day of each month and will be applied to the following month’s fee. (For example, tuition will be withdrawn on August 10th and will be applied to September’s fees.)

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Discounts

- 10% discount for single-parent families
- 5% sibling discount (applies to each additional sibling)
- **Tuition is not pro-rated or discounted** for vacations, time away, or foreseen or unforeseen school closures.
- Only one discount may be applied. Discounts may not be combined.

Included in the Full Day Program's Monthly Tuition

- A morning snack, hot lunch, and an afternoon snack. All fruits, vegetables, and milk are organic.
- Two or three Specialists per grade level, selected each year by the school. Some examples of Specialists in the past have been:
 - Music
 - Spanish
 - Drama
 - Tumble Bus (Gymnastics)
 - Physical Education.

Deposit & Annual Fees

A non-refundable security deposit of one month's tuition is required to reserve your child's space. The security deposit will be credited towards June's tuition. A Registration Fee of \$150 and an Education fee of \$550 are also required upon enrollment and are assessed annually during preregistration. **Deposit and Annual Fees are non-refundable.**

Parent participation in our Cedar Crest Academy Parent Association is mandatory and requires an annual membership fee of approximately \$100 per child. Cedar Crest Academy also requires families to volunteer a minimum of 10 hours throughout the school year.
